First Aid


- 1. In the event of a dancer falling, the partner must raise their hand to alert the Cuer & Sound Manager to halt the music.
- 2. The two nearest couples are also to raise hands to gain attention and remain as 'safety barriers'.
- 3. Under no circumstances should any person lift or assist the fallen dancer before the First Aid Officer or the Assistant has examined the person.
- 4. Other dancers should return to seats and await further instructions.
- 5. If the injury necessitates an ambulance, the First Aid Officer will organise this.
- 6. If an injury occurs away from the dance floor, one person should stay with the one needing attention and another locate the First Aid Officer or the Assistant.

Evacuation

If it is necessary to evacuate the hall, this will be announced by the MC. Please make your way out via the **front Entrance door** or **side Carport door** and meet in the designated Emergency Assembly Area in the carpark. Please do not leave the carpark until your name is checked off the Register. Do not re-enter the hall until told that it is safe to do so.


